



## Volk Swaggin' on the Lake

**On October 25, 26, and 27, 2013, the Town of Hickory Creek is holding an event at Sycamore Bend Park called Volk Swaggin' on the Lake. It is an Air Cooled only VW Bus and Beetle gathering, music festival, and car show. On the 25<sup>th</sup> the park opens at 5pm for campers and vendor setup.**

**Saturday begins with an Arbor Day ceremony, followed by belly dancing and live music. The music acts for Saturday include fiddle player Aaron Mingus at 1:30 pm and country/rock recording artist Matt Dunn at 2:30. Saturday evening kicks off with Hickory Creek's own resident rock star Brent Hillendahl and his band Dusty Vinyl followed by the Led Zepelin tribute band Swan Song. Actor Ernest James of Friday Night Lights will be present as will many former Dallas Cowboy Super Bowl Champs to sign autographs. Vendors, performers and those famous air-cooled VW's will be welcoming guests to the park.**

**Sunday's main event is an air cooled VW car show starting at 9:00am with trophies for Best in Show, Mayor's Choice and Peoples Choice among others. VW enthusiasts from across the region will be on hand showing off their restored and custom rides. There is free entry to the Car Show and the Live Entertainment for all people who volunteer four hours during the weekend, contact Porter Walker at the town hall to sign up.**

After years of planning, the expansion of I-35 is scheduled to begin this fall. TxDOT has set up a website at [35Express.org](http://35Express.org), where citizens can find the most up-to-date information. There are icons to connect for informational updates through Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Email, or Text messaging. During construction, these methods of communication will provide the latest information, including expected lane closures and detours. Please go to [35Express.org](http://35Express.org) and sign up to receive the updates.

The 35Express project extends from US 380 to I-635. The project is expected to relieve traffic congestion in one of the most heavily travelled corridors in the North Texas region. One of the highlights of the project is the construction of managed lanes down the middle of the interstate. The cost to use the managed lanes will vary depending on the time of day and congestion.

Other highlights include additional general purpose lanes, reconstruction of the Belt Line Road and FM 407 interchanges, a new shared path for pedestrians and cyclists across the Lewisville Lake Bridge, and construction of a new southbound bridge over Lewisville Lake

The project has been divided into three segments North, Middle and South, with Hickory Creek in the Middle section. The North segment extends from US 380 to FM 2181. In Phase 1, motorists will have additional lanes along the bridges at North Texas Boulevard, Corinth Parkway, and Post Oak Road. The interstate will travel over Corinth Parkway. In this area, Interstate 35E will have three lanes of traffic in each direction.

The Middle segment extends from FM 2181 to President George Bush Turnpike. Approximately 12 miles in length, this segment will have two managed lanes in the center of the roadway and an additional general purpose lane in each direction.

The south segment stretches from the President George Bush Turnpike to I-635. In this section, Dickerson Parkway will be extended to I-35E and the Belt Line Road interchange will be reconstructed. Commuters will also see widened bridges at Whitlock Lane, Crosby Road, Valwood Parkway and Valley View Lane.

Ranked as one of the most congested roadways in the state, the entire corridor is being reconstructed in two phases. Estimated cost to fund both phases of the project is \$4.8 billion. Funding for Phase I, \$1 billion, has been identified through federal, state and local resources as well as State Highway 121 regional toll revenue funds dedicated to Denton County.
