Dear Fellow Citizens,

On behalf of our Town Council, I want to thank each of you for your patience as we endure this most difficult season. Our offices are closed to the public, but our staff is in place and available by phone, to make sure our town government remains stable. The Council met via teleconference on Monday night, and we will continue remote meetings until further notice. Our police department continues to serve on the front lines of our entire community, and they are here to serve you if needed.

Town Administrator John Smith and I have participated in several conference calls with Governor Gregg Abbott and Denton County Judge Andy Eads. Judge Eads and Commissioner Bobbie Mitchell are doing an excellent job of communicating with us in our local jurisdictions.

Last night, Gov. Abbott issued a new Executive Order, which takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on April 2, 2020 and will end on April 30, 2020. In this order, Gov. Abbott announced a state-wide closure of schools until May 4, 2020, and asks that all Texans stay home unless taking part in essential activities or services.

Our local restaurants have done an outstanding job of moving to a To-Go and Take-Out model. Please continue to support them, and other essential retailers in our area.

We were notified late Monday afternoon of the first positive case of COVID-19 in Hickory Creek. We extend our heartfelt prayers for full recovery to this family, and any family who may be affected in the future.

Please know that I am praying for you and all of our community as we endure these difficult days. We are, and always will be, #HickoryCreekStrong.
